I give my full and unconditional consent to being in any such video or photos as those BCTA project representatives find necessary while making their site activity, progress, security and safety photos.

Further I agree that I am not permitted to and will not take photos nor if by mistake do take some unintentionally, I agree I will delete them immediately and not distribute them to any social media without written consent of the BCTA through a duly authorized representative.

Further I agree to release and hold harmless any BCTA employee or representative (including engineer or Construction Manager, or management of the Contractor) for any action on their part related to enforcing this acknowledgement and agreement affidavit.

- l) Engineer – BCTA’s Project Designer/Engineer of Record (DOR) who produced the design drawings and technical specs for construction. BCTA’s DOR is HDR.
- m) Inspector In Charge – Shall refer to BCTA and/or its Engineer of Record and/or Construction Manager.

Any pronouns used in relation to, or in place of, any of the words or combinations of words, herein defined, shall have the same meaning as the words or combinations of words themselves.

Wherever the words “directed,” “required,” “permitted,” “ordered,” “designated”, “prescribed”, or words of like import are used in the Contract Documents, it shall be understood that the directions, requirements, permission, orders, designation or prescription of BCTA are intended. Similarly, the words “approved”, “acceptable” “suitable”, “satisfactory”, or words of like import shall mean approved by, acceptable to, suitable to, or satisfactory to BCTA (or BCTA’s designated representative(s) Engineer(s) or Construction Manager as may be the case) in each case.

3.07.3 CONTRACTOR RESPONSIBILITIES

The Contractor represents and warrants that is has thoroughly examined and has become familiar with the Contract Documents and determined the nature of the Work, the general and local conditions, the availability of labor, materials, supplies, and equipment and all other matters which can in any way affect the work under this Contract. Failure to make an examination necessary for this determination shall not release the Supplier from the obligations of this Contact nor be grounds for any claim based on unforeseen conditions. Contractor further represents that it will supervise and verify the Work of its Subcontractors and Suppliers and provide all supervision, inspections and quality control and quality assurance testing and inspection of their Work as well as its own Work as may be required by the Contract Documents, Bonds, Warranties and Guarantees to assure full and complete compliance with those Documents, Assurances, Insurances, and Warrantees and Guarantees. No amount of Owner/Owner representative inspections will preclude Contractor’s SOLE responsibility for full and complete compliance with the Contract Documents including all safety and quality control/assurance **services including independent lab material testing and on site field compaction testing assurance services (by Contractor)**, and requirements stated or reasonably implied from the contract documents including reference specifications and standards and or other provisions and requirements referred to by the Contract Documents.

3.07.4 INSURANCE

Proof of insurance shall be submitted prior to starting Work. It shall be the responsibility of the Contractor to make certain that its Subcontractors also comply with these insurance requirements and submit such evidence of coverages as required of Prime Contractor

All insurance required by the Contact Documents (including this section) to be purchased and maintained by the Contractor shall be obtained from insurance companies that are duly licensed or authorized in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania for the issuance of insurance policies for the limits and coverages so required. Such insurance companies shall also meet such additional requirements and qualifications as may be provided in the Contract Documents and provided below.
